John Offerdahl

John Offerdahl, a former All-Pro linebacker for the Miami Dolphins, is a successful restaurateur and community leader. A native of Wisconsin Rapids, Wisconsin, Mr. Offerdahl graduated from West Michigan University (WMU) with a degree in biochemistry. While at WMU, Mr. Offerdahl led the Mid-American Conference in tackles three times and earned numerous national awards. In 1986, Mr. Offerdahl joined the Miami Dolphins as a second-round draft pick. During his eight seasons, he was known for his relentless play, hard hits and leadership. He was named Defensive Rookie of the Year and earned five trips to the Pro Bowl. He retired in 1993 and approached his post-football career with the same drive he showed on the gridiron. Mr. Offerdahl grew his gourmet bagel shop into 10 stores before joining with others to form Einstein Bros. Bagels, a national bagel retailer. Today, he operates seven quick-casual restaurants — Offerdahl's Café and Grill — and his newest venture, the Gridiron Grill-Off Food, Wine & Tailgate Festival, at which fans eat, drink and vote for their favorite recipe. Beyond the restaurants, Mr. Offerdahl has a tireless commitment to his faith and community. A devout Christian, he is currently chairman of the board for the National Christian Foundation of South Florida, a grant-making foundation that supports churches, ministries and Christian-focused not-for-profit organizations. He is a member of the Orange Bowl Committee and board member of the Florida Restaurant and Lodging Association. He lives with his wife, Lynn, and their three children in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida.



Jim Berry

Jim Berry is the weeknight sports anchor for CBS4 News. He also anchors CBS4's Miami Dolphins Coverage and Sports Rap. Jim joined CBS4 in 1996, after working at several other television stations. He is a three-time Best of Miami winner and has won five Emmys. He is also a recipient of the Silver Circle of Excellence award for a distinguished journalism career (Suncoast chapter of the National Academy of Arts and Sciences). Jim has been a frequent motivational speaker, and has been involved with numerous charities.
